Individual participants DCR	In accordance with the ITU/DTU regulations, participants must reach the age of 18 on the day of the event.
Relay teams DCR	<p>Participants must reach the age of 18 on the day of the event.</p> <p>Each relay team consists of a swimmer, a cyclist and a runner.</p> <p>All-female, all-male and mixed relay teams will be eligible to take part.</p>
Trophy relay teams DCR	<p>Special offer for company relay teams.</p> <p>There will be an editorial contribution about each company in the program booklet. In addition, there will be a separate award ceremony for the fastest Trophy relay teams at the finish-line stadium on race day.</p> <p>Each member of a Trophy relay team will receive a present.</p>
World-Championship of Firefighters Individual and Relay	<p>Only firefighters (female or male) can take part in the World Championship of Firefighters.</p> <p>In order to take part, please click the appropriate button during online registration.</p> <p>After registration, athletes are asked to immediately send a copy of their service card or a confirmation issued by their employer to the event organizer via mail, fax or e-mail (scanned copy).</p> <p>All participants in the World-Championship of Firefighter will be specially mentioned in the program booklet.</p>
Team Competition (DCR and World-Championship of Firefighters)	<p>Each team consists of participants of the same sex. The results of the three best athletes of each club will count.</p> <p>Attention: All team participants are asked to indicate the name of their club in exactly the same spelling (including potential abbreviations) in their registration forms, so that the registration system can identify them as team members.</p>
SUB9	<p>All athletes who indicate a finishing time of less than 9 hours will automatically be classified as SUB9.</p> <p>If they indeed finish the race in less than 9 hours, their entry fee will be subsequently reduced to EUR 99.00, and the surplus will be reimbursed.</p> <p>Furthermore, all SUB9 athletes will be specially mentioned in the program booklet.</p>

Entry fees	All athletes, who were registered for DATEV Challenge Roth on July 4th 2021, and who were not able to register for the new-scheduled event on September 5th 2021, can register free of charge for the event on July 3rd 2022.
Methods of payment	In case further products or services are purchased during the registration, payment can only be made by bank transfer, direct debit or credit card (Visa or Mastercard). Bank transfer fees are always at the participant's expense.
Free entry	All athletes who have reached place 1 to 10 in the DATEV Challenge Roth 2019 in the overall classification (male/female), will be entitled to free entry for the 2021 race.
Additional costs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Euro 30.00 for a day license (only for athletes without a valid license of a triathlon federation) In case the athlete had already purchased a day license for the July 4th event, and did not take the chance to participate at the re-scheduled event on September 5th 2021, the day license will be transferred free of charge to the new event on July 3rd 2022. • If the timing-chip is damaged or lost, a fee of Euro 50.00 will be charged. Detailed information regarding returning the transponders are included in the Race Regulations. • For all athletes, participation in the carbo party is included in the entry fee. In addition, there is a limited number of tickets for accompanying persons. They are available at Euro 20.00 each at the Athletes' Service Point and at the Information Desk. Free entry for children under 12 years. In case the athlete had already purchased tickets for the pasta party for the July 2021 event, and did not take the chance to participate at the re-scheduled event on September 2021, the tickets will be transferred free of charge to the new event on July 3rd 2022.
Registration	Registration can generally only be effected online via our homepage www.challenge-roth.com/an-abmeldung.html
Further information regarding registration	<p>The organizer is entitled to reject a registration without giving any specific reasons (so-called freedom of contract).</p> <p>If there is a legitimate reason (e. g. if athletes are suspected to disturb the race), the organizer reserves the right to subsequently withdraw the registration and to exclude the participant from taking part.</p> <p>In addition, in case of any violation of rules, the organizer always has the right to disqualify athletes in consultation with the race jury.</p> <p>The organizer reserves the right to punish participants who are disqualified due to obvious fraud with a lifelong prohibition from participation in DATEV Challenge Roth.</p> <p>Swapping start places is generally excluded for individual participants. In any case of contravention, a lifelong prohibition from participation in DATEV Challenge Roth will be imposed on both athletes.</p> <p>As soon as the maximum number of registrations has been reached, no further registrations will be accepted.</p>

Withdrawal of registration	<p>Until March 31st, 2022, participants will have a right to withdraw their registration, in which case the entry fee will be reimbursed with deduction of a handling fee of Euro 90.00.</p> <p>For start slots out of the December 6th pre-Christmas Auction the handling fee amounts to EUR 140.00 (including the EUR 50.00 charity donation).</p> <p>After March 31st, 2022 entry fees will no longer be reimbursed.</p> <p>Registration can only be withdrawn via the Withdrawal Form on our homepage at www.challenge-roth.com/an-abmeldung.html.</p> <p>Upon sending their withdrawal request, athletes are asked to indicate their IBAN and SWIFT Nos. for reimbursement of the entry fee.</p> <p>Any bank fees are at the participant's expense.</p>												
Entry Protection Plan	<p>Again athletes of the DATEV Challenge Roth have the opportunity to buy an entry protection plan at a price of EUR 79.00 which contains the following services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The right to withdraw the registration lasts until Saturday July 3rd, 2021 – 12:00 a.m. (Reception of the withdraw by Fax or Mail). Until this point of time the entry fee will be reimbursed with deduction of the handling fee mentioned above. - Guarantee of a start slot for DATEV Challenge Roth 2022. The slot is only valid for the following year and cannot forwarded to an other person. <p>The entry protection plan can be ordered – even supplementary – until December 31st, 2020 at 24:00 p.m. within the online registration.</p> <p>In case the athlete had already purchased an entry protection plan for the for the July 2021 event, and did not take the chance to participate at the re-scheduled event on September 2021, the entry protection plan will be transferred free of charge to the new event on July 3rd 2022.</p>												
Distances / Course details	<p>3.8 km swim in Main-Donau-Canal, start and finish at the Hilpolstein landing stage.</p> <p>180 km bike course, consisting of two laps in the southern county of Roth, little traffic, 90 % of the course is closed for oncoming traffic</p> <p>Drafting is prohibited! On the bike course, the road traffic regulations (StVO) are binding!</p> <p>42.195 km run course on roads in and around Roth as well as in Büchenbach, completely closed to traffic. Widely flat course.</p>

Medical service	<p>Bayerisches Rotes Kreuz (Bavarian Red Cross) Wasserwacht Roth (Water Rescue Service Roth)</p>
Sanitary facilities	<p>Toilets are located at the transition zones, all aid stations and at the finish-line area.</p> <p>Shower facilities are located at the finish-line area. There will be separate showers at the transition zones for relay swimmers and relay cyclists.</p>
Food and drink	<p>Aid stations are always located at the same distances and offer food and drink in the same order:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bike course: approx. every 17.5 km • run course: approx. every 2 km • finish-line area • Athletes can bring their own food and drink and ask accompanying persons to pass them the food and drink at any aid station (bike and run course). <p>Every athlete is asked to organize the provision of their own food and drink with the help of accompanying persons. The race organizer does not assume any responsibility for this private service.</p> <p>Details regarding the aid stations and the food and drink that are offered there are included in the Race Regulations.</p>
Start times and finish closing time	<p>The race will be started in several start groups, beginning at 6.30 a.m.</p> <p>The last start groups are reserved for relay teams.</p> <p>The exact allocation of start groups, including start times of the groups will be included in the Race Regulations.</p> <p>Finish closing time: approx. 11.05 p.m. at the Roth festival ground</p>
Collecting the start documents	<p>Thursday, June 30th between 10 am and 7 p.m. Friday, July 1st between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Saturday, July 2nd, between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.</p> <p>Attention: Please bring your identity card, start pass of your national federation and your start number when collecting your start documents.</p>
Check-in and check-out times for bikes and athletes' bags	<p>Bike check-in: Saturday, July 2nd at the swim start (canal landing stage Hilpoltstein) between 11.30 a.m. and 4 p.m.</p> <p>The check-in and check-out times for the athletes' bags and the times for bike check-out will be listed in detail in the Race Regulations.</p>

<p>Race meeting</p>	<p>It is obligatory for all athletes to attend the race meeting.</p> <p>It will take place on Saturday, July 2nd, 2021 at the pavilion in Roth at the following times:</p> <p>1.00 p.m. – Spanish 2.00 p.m. – French 3.00 p.m. – individual participants English 4.00 p.m. – individual participants German 5.00 p.m. – relay teams German</p> <p>For English-speaking relay teams there will be a separate race meeting at the press center at the clubhouse at 5.30 p.m.</p>
<p>Award ceremony</p>	<p>The DCR award ceremony takes place on Monday, July 4th, at the pavilion in Roth as of 11 a.m.</p> <p>The award ceremony for the World Championship of Firefighters takes place on Monday, July 4th, at the Roth fire station at 2 p.m.</p>

Pace Euro 500.00 <p>in total Euro 62,000.00</p> <p>For foreign participants, withholding tax will be retained in accordance with German tax regulations.</p> <p>Prize money will not be paid until the official results of the doping tests are received. Price money will only be paid to top ten finishers, who can provide a pro license when they collect their start documents. A “move-up procedure” is not in charge.</p>
<p>Prize money for relay teams (DCR)</p>	<p>For the first three relay teams (male, female, mixed) the following minimum amounts of prize money are guaranteed:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. place Euro 900.00 2. place Euro 600.00 3. place Euro 300.00
<p>Non-cash prizes (DCR) (individual and relay)</p>	<p>All individual participants who finish the competition within the time limit of 15 hours, will receive the official DCR finisher’s shirt.</p> <p>All relay participants whose relay team finishes the competition within the time limit of 13 hours and 45 minutes, will receive a special finisher’s shirt for relay teams. The fastest age-group athletes will receive a present.</p>

<p>Special prizes (DCR) (individual and relay)</p>	<p>Athletes who reach the 1st to 3rd place of each age group (female and male), will receive trophies.</p> <p>Teams or relay teams who reach the 1st to 3rd place (female and male), will receive special prizes.</p> <p>Each finisher will receive an instant certificate at the finish-line area.</p> <p>Athletes who reach a place among the top ten finishers are excluded from age-group classification.</p>
<p>Medical treatment of the participant</p> <p>No insurance for medical treatment via the organizer</p>	<p>If medical treatment of the participant should be necessary during the event, the participant in advance declares his consent thereto.</p> <p>Medical services are not included in the entry fee and the participant shall be directly charged therefor in accordance with the usual medical tariffs.</p> <p>The organizer shall not provide any insurance coverage for medical treatment and is not obliged to do so. It is within the responsibility of each participant to ensure sufficient insurance coverage for medical treatment. Any liability on the part of the organizer in relation to any insurance coverage for medical treatment shall be excluded.</p>
<p>Personal responsibility of participants for technical safety of equipment</p>	<p>According to DTU sports regulations, §7.2 each participant is responsible for the technical safety of their equipment and is to make sure that the equipment is in line with the rules.</p>
